Preamble:

Smt. V.T.Kevadia & Smt.D.R. Kikani Charitable Trust, Bhavnagar had applied for affiliation for Swami Vivekanand Homeopathic College to Bhavnagar University to teach Homeopathic Course from the year 2000-2001.

The Deptt. Of Education, after due scrutiny, allowed, in principle, the sanction for affiliation of Swami Vivekanand Homeopathic College, Bhavnagar to Bhavnagar University by their letter dt. 4-5-2000 read at [1] above. The Registrar, Council of Homeopathic System of Medicines has submitted the inspection report of Swami Vivekanand Homeopathic College by their letter dt. 16-5-2000 read at [2] above.

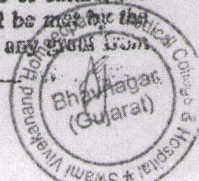
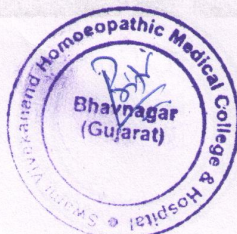
The matter of recognition to Swami Vivekanand Homeopathic College to start first year of B H M S Course from educational year 2000-2001, with 50 seats was under consideration of the Government, under reference to the Deptt. of Edn. letter dt. 2-5-2000 read at [1] above, being in principle sanction for affiliation to Bhavnagar University and inspection report submitted by the Registrar, Council of Homeopathic System of Medicines, Ahmedabad letter dt. 16-5-2000 read at [2] above.

Resolution:

After careful consideration by Government of Gujarat, it has been decided to grant recognition to Swami Vivekanand Homeopathic College, Bhavnagar, to start first year of B H M S Course from educational year 2000-2001, with 50 seats, subject to following conditions.

[1] Swami Vivekanand Homeopathic College will obtain necessary sanctions from the Central Council Of Homeopathic Medicines, New Delhi from time to time as may be required and if such sanctions are not obtained and if problem of refund of fees and other related problems arises, total responsibility will rest with the College

[2] In pursuance Of the recognition of the College, all expenditure, current or future, for administration of the College, including fees and allowances to the staff will be met by the College resources and the institution / College will not ask for any grant from



[3] All the conditions put forth by the Government, the University and Council of Homoeopathic Medicines will be duly fulfilled in due time by the College

[4] All the minimum facilities such as teaching staff, Building, Laboratory Equipments, hospital facilities, library etc. required for starting the course, as per provisions of the Homoeopathy [minimum standard education] Regulation Act - 1983, will be made available from the beginning of the first term. The College will obtain necessary sanctions from the Central Council Of Homoeopathic Medicines, New Delhi, from time to time, as required and if such sanctions are not obtained, all the responsibility for the problems that may arise, will rest with the College.

[5] All the facilities for Homoeopathic College, its laboratories and other educational facilities as required by the Central Council Of Homoeopathic Medicines, New Delhi and by Bhavnagar University, will be made available by the College.

[6] The in principle sanction has been granted by the Education Department by their letter dtd.4-5-2000 for affiliation to Bhavnagar University. therefore, sanction for affiliation to the University will have to be obtained from Education Department at the earliest. If sanction from The Central Council Of Homoeopathic Medicines, New Delhi is not available for want of affiliation with University, under such circumstances, the responsibility for the problems that may arise for this situation, and for the completion of the course of students will rest with the College / Institution..

[7] The College will reserve the seats for scheduled caste, scheduled tribes and Backward candidates, as decided by the Government from time to time.

[8] The College will regulate the students' admissions as per the suggestions of the Government through the Chairman of the Central Admission Committee and the College will adopt the standard of fees as may be regulated by the Government from time to time.
